INTRODUCTION PROJECT  The focus for the start of the course is to further develop & build on skills taught at KS3 through a variety of techniques and media based on a theme.  The focus on the Autumn Term will be on students having the opportunity to explore a range of disciplines such as drawing and painting, digital art, textile and mixed media techniques, and 3D skills. They will develop ideas in the style of featured artists, craftspeople and designers, and produce their own response as a developmental final piece.  This mini project will prepare students for the start of the coursework project which is 60% of the overall GCSE grade.	COURSEWORK PROJECT Students will continue to develop skills and reflect on work produced in the Autumn Term.  The coursework project is based on a theme determined by the student and their interests.  Spring Term is focussed on research based on the chosen theme, drawing skills, and making connections to selected artists through experimental work in a variety of different specialisms.  Developed work will be presented as the first final outcome for the coursework project.	COURSEWORK PROJECT Students will develop their original studies by working in the style of their chosen artists, craftspeople and designers.  Work is continually refined and revisited to enable students to produce their best possible outcomes.  The Portfolio project is presented and submitted for assessment.

COURSEWORK PROJECT This term is dedicated to students producing their final outcomes for their project. It builds upon the preparatory studies and developments from previous terms.  They will add final refinements before completing their Final Piece. This concludes the coursework (portfolio) element of the course.	EXAM PROJECT The Spring Term is dedicated to the externally set examination project that makes up the final 40% of marks for the award.  Students will use all the techniques and approaches developed during the coursework project but in a much shorter timescale.  The examination paper is issued to students at the start of the Spring Term. The paper will provide several titles that act as starting points for a themed project. Students will be required to select different artists than the ones they studied in their coursework. Students will do preparatory work leading to a final piece done under examination conditions for 10 hours at around Easter time.  Students will be taught and supported to display their work for final assessment in a professional manner ready for external moderation.
